Event Disclaimer

You agree that to the best of your knowledge, you are fit and well and understand the physical nature of this event.

You agree to abide by all applicable rules as set out below and on the risk assessment.

Your participation in this running event is entirely at your own risk. You agree that the race organisers, organisations or landowners will not be held responsible or liable for any injury, illness, loss or damage to you or your property which you may sustain in the course of, or because of taking part in the event.

You acknowledge that refunds, transfers and deferrals are not permitted

In order for your child/ren to participate in the Wing Family Fest Colour Run, you must accept the following waiver prior to the event.

1. **Guardianship:** I confirm that I am 18 or over and the legal guardian of the child(ren) registered to participate in the Colour Run on 7th July 2024
2. **Safety Rules:** I agree that my child will participate in the Colour Run Challenge in accordance with the specific safety rules clearly explained by volunteers at the beginning of the Colour Run.
3. **Colour:** I understand that participating in the Colour Run is a potentially hazardous activity where the coloured powder will be thrown at and around my child during the event. However, I understand that the powder is not harmful to people, animals or plant life.
4. **Risk of Injury:** I understand that participation in the event involves inherent risks, including but not limited to physical injury, cuts, scrapes, bruises, sprains, strains, dehydration, and heat exhaustion. I acknowledge that these risks are greater than those encountered in everyday life.
5. **Health and Safety:** Participants are required to follow all safety rules and instructions provided by event volunteers, including the wearing of protective eyewear (sunglasses or goggles) as mandated by the event's safety guidelines. All participants must behave appropriately, respecting fellow participants, volunteers, staff, and property. Protective eyewear will be provided in the runners' pack, but participants may also wear their own prescription eyewear if necessary. Adherence to these safety and behaviour guidelines is essential, and failure to comply may result in denial of participation. Please see the [ingredient listing](#) for the paint that will be used.

6. **Fitness:** I acknowledge that the Colour Run is suitable for participants of all abilities and that obstacles can be bypassed if needed. As the legal guardian, it is my responsibility to assess my child's physical fitness to participate in the event. I understand the physical demands of the activity and acknowledge the risk of injury. Should there be any concerns about my child's ability to safely complete the course, I will consult a healthcare professional before the event and notify the organisers of any significant health issues that could affect participation.
7. **Rules and Regulations:** I agree to abide by all rules and regulations established by the organisers.
8. **Safeguarding:** Parents/carers are to be reminded that they are responsible for their child/children at the event at all times
9. **Photography:** There will be a drone and a photographer capturing the day. Images may be used for any purpose, including but not limited to, promoting the event for both schools on social media, websites, marketing materials, and other publications.
10. **Weather:** Remind children and their carers to bring appropriate clothing for outdoor weather, all conditions and for exercising. i.e. if a hot day, wear a sunhat, apply sun cream, drink plenty of water and wear appropriate footwear
11. I hereby indemnify ***The Friends of Cottesloe and Friends of Overstone*** against any claims related to loss, damage or injury that may occur during the event.
