<p><b>Subject Content A thematic course covering 750 years of warfare from the medieval period to the present times. This unit covers the themes of the nature and experience of war, technological change, recruitment and training and the role of women in warfare</b></p> <p><b>A depth study of the Blitz in World War Two is also covered and requires the students to assess and evaluate historical sources</b></p>

<b>Assessment Details:</b>			
<p>To be successful students will need to be able to:</p> <p>Demonstrate their knowledge of change over time by comparing issues and events over time.</p> <p>Demonstrate historical understanding and source evaluation.</p> <p>Exam questions will be set for homework and once a half term students will be assessed formally in the lesson.</p> <p>Students need to learn the narrative of this part of history and identify changes and continuities over the 750 year period.</p> <p>They will also have to develop knowledge of significant battles and conflicts in this period and how these demonstrate change over time.</p> <p>Alongside the thematic study, which looks at the nature and experience of warfare, there is a depth study of the Blitz. This is a source-based unit of study.</p>			
<b>What can I do to support my child at home?</b>			
<p>The best way to learn a topic is to teach it to others and so you can discuss and question your child about what they have been doing in school in history. Ask them to explain how warfare developed, what were the significant turning points, what changed and what stayed the same?</p>
