

<p>Students follow the Pearson BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in Health and Social Care. This qualification is equivalent to one A level. It comprises of four units (three of these are mandatory). Assessment Details:			
<p>In year 13 Health and Social Care students will be regularly assessed on their portfolio work in strict accordance with the specification guidelines. Submission dates for all work is published at the start of the year and it is the responsibility of the students to meet these deadlines. For the portfolio assignments students will have just one opportunity to improve work following feedback.
