What do you feel about changes to school uniform?

Can we wear other jewellery?

Jewellery can be expensive and easily lost or damaged at school therefore we keep it to a minimum.

These will be displayed in student reception. There is always a HOY on duty every breaktime and a member of SLT. Mr Wilson is in charge of duty staff so please see him if you have a concern. Mr Jones is always on break/lunch duty in the main canteen.

Staff have allocated duty points, some are on duty in the same areas they are busy places, e.g. coach park. Please feel free to approach staff if you need something.

Supervision indoors in wet weather.

The hall is open at lunchtime if the weather is poor. Duty staff are moved indoors to monitor the corridors if the students are indoors.

New TEAM Hub?

Love the new space. It is calm. Out of the way from main school. We love Teddy! Some liked this others did not. The Hub was relocated so it was in a quiet, designated space just for wellbeing. The old LINC was shared with Youth Club and it was not very welcoming and had poor facilities.

Opening times not clear.

TEAM Hub is open before school, break and lunchtime for drop ins. You may be referred their for specific help but otherwise it is open to all. We have dedicated and trained sixth form wellbeing ambassadors to support the staff who work in TEAM Hub.

Did not know what was on offer. Need more clubs other than PE/ performing arts.

Clubs are all posted on the school website. There is a timetable for each year group. Tutors should have this on their noticeboards. There are clubs for science, debating, Warhammer, etc. just check out the website.
